The Itasca-Mantrap Electric Cooperative Board of Directors has hired Steven Johnson as its new President & Chief Executive Officer. Johnson's duties as CEO will begin December 2, 2024. He will be replacing Christine Fox, who is retiring after 10 years with the cooperative. The board's national search resulted in a large number of candidates, and an extensive round of interviews concluded that Johnson was the best person to lead the cooperative forward.

Johnson has been in the electric cooperative industry for over 25 years having served most recently as the CEO for the Yampa Valley Electric Cooperative in Steamboat Springs, CO. Prior to that, he was the Chief Operations Officer for Yampa Valley and the Operations Manager for Meeker Cooperative in Litchfield, Minnesota. ## **Operation Round Up Update!**

Operation Round Up (ORU), a charitable program unique to electric co-ops, is designed to provide financial assistance to non-profit or community-based organizations that demonstrate a commitment to enhancing the quality of life in the local area served by Itasca-Mantrap.

The Itasca-Mantrap Operation Round Up® Trust Board recently awarded \$37,670 in Operation Round Up grants for 72 civic projects in the Itasca-Mantrap and surrounding area. While ORU received applications for more grants, all requests could not be granted due to limited funding.
Since the program's inception in 2006, Operation
Round Up has awarded over \$1.3 million to local
organizations, thanks to the generosity of ItascaMantrap members.

The Operation Round Up Trust Board meets twice a year to select grant recipients from the applications received. The next application deadline is Monday, March 17, 2025. To apply, download the most recent application from the Itasca-Mantrap website.
